A. CHATFIELD SITE SPECIFIC NUTRIENT STANDARD PLANNING (ALAN LEAK & MICHAEL DAUGHERTY)

A quote was provided by James McCutchan. Background was provided. The deliverables
and proposed estimated budget were shared. The subcommittee will meet to make a
review and bring a recommendation to the full TAC. The quote is within the budget to
begin next year. The proposed schedule may have Mr. McCutchen begin the work this



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year with the intent to be prepared to present a recommendation to the Commission in 2026.

UPDATES (3:15 P.M. - 3:55 P.M.)

A. TECHNICAL (ALAN LEAK)

- 1. Regulation 22 Site Location Approval No. 3251, Perry Park Water and Sanitation District applied for an amendment to their existing plant. RESPEC found there wasn't an impact to their phosphorus loading. It was an upgrade, and it will improve water quality. CWA sent in an approval. It was found in conformance by the Division and was approved.
- 2. Draft 2024 Chatfield Watershed Authority Budget (Alan Leak) (<u>Chatfield Watershed Authority Budget Planning Workbook 2024-2028 Version 8-29-2023</u>) The budget in the package is the same. Be aware that for 2024 \$80,000 is dedicated to nonspecific (NPS) activities. The McCutchen quote would be applied to this nonspecific category. CWA has room in the 2023 budget to begin the project if the Authority chooses to do so.
- 3. Regulation #93 Data Call The 303d data for the Division has been submitted.
- 4. Chatfield Reservoir Mitigation Company Update None.
- 5. Other Member Hilldale Pines Forest Break project update The Colorado Watershed Assembly has agreed to become the lead applicant for a COSWAP grant, hire a Project Manager to work with the Youth Corps members, and provide the necessary insurance, administrative support, and overall grant management services. The Authority has committed \$5,000 to this project.

- 1. New Chatfield Watershed Authority Board Member Douglas County Commissioner George Teal. (Chatfield WA New Board Appointment)
- 2. <u>Website News Announcement</u> Preservation of 204 acres of open space via a conservation easement in Douglas County. A map of the easement was provided and discussed. This is a benefit to water quality and the elk that migrate through the area. The County may develop a small piece for their operations.
